

Assumption Of Risk Relating To COVID-19 Agreement

Bring On The Music, Inc. dba Silverlake Conservatory of Music (the “Conservatory”) has put in place preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. COVID-19, or the novel coronavirus, has been declared a worldwide pandemic and is **extremely contagious**. It is believed to spread between people who are in close contact with one another. It is the goal of the Conservatory to protect students and staff to the fullest extent possible, while allowing musical education to continue in person. This Agreement highlights the many measures the Conservatory is taking to combat the spread of COVID-19 and to safeguard individuals on its premises. However, the Conservatory **cannot guarantee** that these measures will prevent students and visitors on our premises from becoming infected with COVID-19. Furthermore, attending the Conservatory in person **could increase your risk and your children’s risk** of contracting COVID-19, despite the social distancing and aggressive hygienic and disinfection measures that the Conservatory has put in place.

Measures To Reduce Spread Of Covid-19

To protect students, parents, teachers, employees, and all other individuals, the Conservatory has implemented the following measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19:

1. The Conservatory asks students not to attend lessons if they are experiencing any symptoms related to COVID-19. Any individual who is experiencing COVID-19 symptoms, who is confirmed to have COVID-19, or who has been in close contact (i.e., within six feet for ten or more minutes) with any person confirmed or suspected of having COVID-19 within the past 14 days shall not be permitted to enter the Conservatory’s premises. According to the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”), COVID-19 symptoms include: cough; shortness of breath or trouble breathing; fever; chills; repeated shaking with chills; muscle pain; headache; sore throat; increased tiredness or fatigue; or new loss of taste or smell.
2. The Conservatory will perform temperature checks on all individuals who enter the Conservatory, including students, visitors and employees. These temperature checks will be conducted by trained personnel using a non-contact thermometer. Any individual who has a body temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher will be excluded from the Conservatory’s premises for either: (1) 14 days; (2) until

provision of a negative test result for COVID-19; or (iii) for employees, until certification from a health care professional for fitness for duty. All results of the temperature checks will be kept confidential. The Conservatory will record only whether a temperature indicates that an individual has a fever and will use this information only to determine whether to permit individuals to enter the Conservatory's premises and for no other purpose. Any individual not agreeing to the temperature check will not be permitted to enter the Conservatory.

3. The Conservatory will limit the number of people permitted inside its premises.
4. The Conservatory requires all individuals to adhere to physical distancing by maintaining at least six feet of space between each person on the premises when possible. Thus, during music lessons, teachers will maintain at least six feet of physical distance from their students. In addition, plexiglass partitions will be utilized in classrooms for our vocal, woodwind and brass instruments.
5. The Conservatory requires all teachers to wear face shields and/or face coverings at all times during lessons. The Conservatory also requires all employees and visitors, including students, to use cloth face coverings while on the Conservatory's premises, with the exception that students and teachers who are unable to play their respective instruments with a cloth face covering may remove the face covering when playing their instruments.
6. All individuals will be instructed to frequently and thoroughly wash their hands (scrubbing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds) at the outdoor wash basin. Hand sanitizer with at least 60% ethanol or 70% isopropanol will be available as well. Individuals will be required to wash their hands at the following key times: before and after lessons, before and after breaks, before and after work shifts, after blowing their nose, coughing or sneezing, after using the restroom, and before eating or preparing food. The Conservatory will supply hand sanitizers throughout its premises for students, employees, teachers, and other individuals to use at any time.
7. The Conservatory will frequently disinfect commonly shared equipment in high traffic areas, such as door handles and faucet handles. In addition, all commonly shared instruments stored on the Conservatory's premises will be disinfected before and after each musical lesson.
8. All individuals will be instructed to avoid person-to-person contact, such as shaking hands, hugging, fist-bumping, etc.

9. Bathrooms will be off limits at this time.

Assumption Of Risk Agreement

By signing this agreement, I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that my child(ren) and I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by attending the Conservatory and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, or death. I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Conservatory may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, Conservatory employees, teachers, and/or other students and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to my child(ren) or myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I or my child(ren) may experience or incur in connection with my or my child(ren)'s attendance at the Conservatory or participation in Conservatory classes or programming.
